The MBJYC Junior Instructors are role models for all participants in the Program, and will be required to demonstrate at all times a positive attitude and a genuine enthusiasm for the sport of sailing. With a strong focus on the importance of safety, but never forgetting the joy associated with the sport, the Junior Instructors will be tasked with assisting Instructors in lesson planning, actual sailboat handling instruction and explanation of sailing techniques and racing rules. Junior Instructors will also provide on-the-water demonstrations of their skills and sailing techniques. Junior Instructors will be required to instruct for one full day per week of program participation. On their instructing days, Junior Instructors will report directly to the instructors they are assigned to, and ultimately report to the Head Instructor and Sailing Director.
